## Retention



The original hard copy of the forms should be stored by the relevant club, league, member the application is being completed for, for 6 months and stored in line with General Data Protection Regulations

After the 6 months period a soft copy version is optional.

All copies of the forms and relevant ID for the applications should be retained for the length of time the applicant is with the organisation for if they leave prior to the end of the vetting period or for the active vetting period

Once a new application is made for an applicant the old forms should be destroyed in line with General Data Protection Regulation

**<u>Returned:</u>** Error with application, applicant will have received an email from FAIconnect@Fai.ie detailing the error. Application need to be corrected and reapplied.

**Confirmed:** Application has been reviewed by the Child Welfare Team and processed on the National Vetting Bureau System. Applicant should then receive an email from the Bureau to the next part of the process.

**<u>Passed</u>**: The application has completed the process, and the completion letter will be available to download on the applicant's course tab on My Comet.

## Vetting Procedure Summary



Applicant completes NVB1 form and presents the Validator the completed form and correct ID The Validator checks the ID and signs the Identity document validation form. Copy of the forms should be made and the original forms left with organisation, copy of IDs should be take by organations.

Copies of the application forms and IDs should be **submitted** on Comet system Application is reviewed by FAI Safeguarding team, **returned** to applicant on system if there is an error. If application is ok, the information will then be inputted into the National Vetting Bureau (NVB) system.

When in **Confirmed** status on Comet the Applicant should have received an email from the National Vetting Bureau with an invitation to the next part of the process (valid for 30 days).

Applicant should then complete the part on National Vetting Bureau system. This is then reviewed by the FAI Liaison persons and then submitted to NVB for checks.

Once the National Vetting Bureau has returned the disclosures, the FAI liaison persons download them and review. If there are no convictions the application is **passed** on the comet system, and the applicant can access a confirmation letter electronically
