Role Responsibilities

- Point of contact Be available to work with coaches in relation to all matters and be a point of support within the Academy section for all matters.
- Coordinate Coordinate The Little Saints Academy each week to provide an educational and fun footballing experience for all players in attendance.
- Recruit and retain coaches/volunteers Identify new potential coaches/volunteers for the Academy section, whilst also ensuring to retain and manage current coaches at the club. Ensure that all safeguarding and vetting processes are adhered to for all coaches/volunteers.
- Develop coaches / volunteers Work closely with all coaches/volunteers within the SSG section, with regard to assisting their development and ensuring that that they operate in a safe challenging environment.
- Market Work closely with The Board of the club to market the Academy in relevant areas to increase player numbers.
- Execute club development plan Work closely with Director of Football and coaches to develop and execute a consistent club development plan for the Academy section.
- Assist in the transition of players to U8 Players progressing from The Little Saints Academy to U8.
- Be innovative Ensure to be innovative in approach, with new methods which

work within the parameters of the club development plan.

• In-house Coach Education Workshops - Work with Director of Football and all Academy coaches to deliver in-house coach education workshops for all coaches, in line with the club's development plan.
