

Volunteer Recruitment Procedure

The following steps have been created to provide a safe and positive environment to work and learn.

Role Descriptions

The club will provide a clear role description to include Main Duties/Responsibilities, Qualifications, Attributes Required, Skills Required and an estimated time commitment.

Interview

All volunteers will go through an informal meeting with committee members. The purpose of this is to identify the volunteer's ability to carry out the role as described

Reference

Where possible, volunteers will be asked to provide references from previous clubs.

Garda Vetting & Safeguarding

In line with legislation and the clubs SafeGuarding Policy everyone volunteering at the club (or those from outside the club providing a service) will require Garda Vetting and attend a Safeguarding 1 course before starting their role.
